'I have learnt lots of things this year. I did lots of writing. It was hard but I know how to do it now.' – Zain

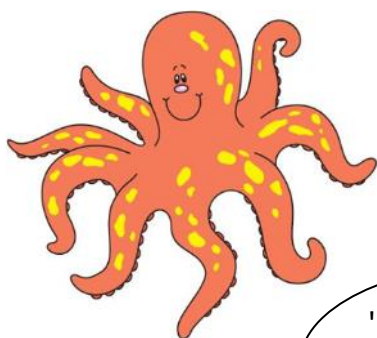

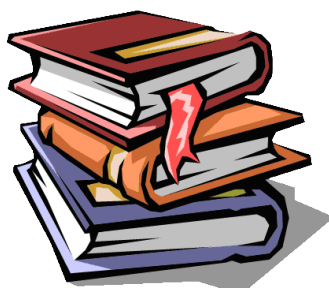

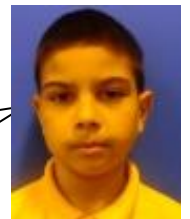
## Kangaroo Class
