Remember:

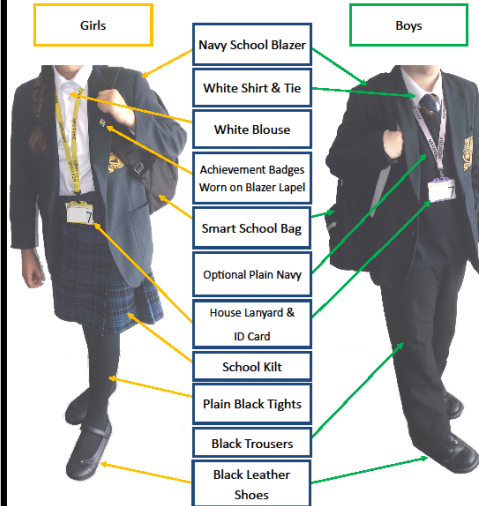
- No outdoor garments, **including scarves** to be worn inside the buildings

Uniform

We are really proud of our uniform at Edmonton County School, so please make sure when you are both in and outside of school you wear it correctly. Below is how you should look at all times.



Uniform Basics

Boys:

- Plain white collared shirt, buttoned to the neck
- School tie
- Black tailored trousers
- Black or white socks

Girls:

- Plain white reverse collar blouse
- Tartan kilt. This should be knee length. A longer skirt can be purchased by special order if demanded for religious reasons
- OR black tailored loose fitting trousers
- Plain navy blue or black hijab or headscarf, if required for religious reasons. The face must be clearly visible at all times
- Black or white calf length socks OR black tights

ID Cards and Lanyards

Students are provided with an ID card, a House colour lanyard and a case.

These items are part of Edmonton County School uniform and should be worn around the neck at all times the student is on school premises.

Should students lose, break or deface these items they are expected to replace them at their own cost immediately:

- Lanyard £1.00
- ID card £1.00
- Wallet £0.25



Smart School Trousers



No trainers of any description, not even black ones



No frilly (or ANY) ankle socks over the top of your long socks.

1 pair of knee-high socks or tights to be worn.



No long nails OR nail varnish- for Health and Safety reasons!

Blazers must be **worn at all times.**

No jumpers should be worn without a blazer.
