



## Able, Gifted and Talented Bursary Scheme

Our aim is to offer financial assistance to the parents/carers of students on the Able, Gifted and Talented Register who would not otherwise be able to afford some of the opportunities available.

Each application will be considered on its own merits. An application does not unfortunately guarantee receipt of any monies. Every effort will be made to ensure a fair decision is reached, but the school's decision is final and will also depend on the number of applications received during the year.

It is our hope that by making available small bursaries, Able, Gifted and Talented students at Edmonton County School will be able to benefit from extension, enrichment or challenge activities (in school, locally and nationally) which might enthuse and motivate them in subjects which may or may not be directly related to the curriculum. We believe that self-esteem and confidence are also likely to be increased when students become involved in this type of extra-curricular activity and therefore wish to encourage our students in this way.

### **Bursary Criteria Guidelines**

Essential Criteria:

- Student/s must be on the Edmonton County School Able, Gifted and Talented Register
- Activity is an educational and is an extension, enrichment or challenge activity

Desirable Criteria

(one or more may apply – please enter this information on the application form)

- Eligible for Free School Meals
- Claiming Free School Meals
- One parent family
- Parent(s) unemployed
- Looked after child (LAC)
- Families with multiple school-age children (four or more)
- Other special circumstances (this will need to be clarified on the application form)

If you are successful with your application for a bursary on your son or daughter's behalf, monies will be paid directly to any course provider (details of which must be provided in your application), either by cheque or electronic bank transfer – there will be no cash payments.
