This letter contains information regarding our expectations around PE kit for the coming school year.

As students are now being asked to come into school in their PE kit on the days where they have a PE lesson timetabled, we are re-issuing our guidance on PE kit which can be found on the website:

Students in Years 7- 10

PE kit for students in these years should be as follows:

- Edmonton County PE Polo Shirt
- Edmonton County PE Shorts
- Edmonton County PE Skirt
- Edmonton County Tracksuit top
- Edmonton County Tracksuit Trousers (joggers)
- Edmonton County PE Socks
- Trainers *with non-marking soles*

Students should not be wearing other items of PE clothing in place of these. If they are wearing a coat to keep warm, it should be plain navy blue or black.

Students in Year 11

PE kit for students in these years should be as follows:

- Edmonton County PE Polo Shirt
- Edmonton County PE Skirt
- Trainers *with non-marking soles*

* Students in year 11 will be allowed to wear tracksuit bottoms, so long as they are **plain navy blue or black**

* Students should not be wearing leggings in place of the PE skirt

Students should not be wearing other items of PE clothing in place of these. If they are wearing a coat to keep warm, it should be plain navy blue or black.

From Monday 14th September students not complying with these uniform expectations will be issued a uniform detention.
