### Catch-Up Assessments

- The event will take place in the Assembly Hall on both Campuses.
- The event will begin at 11am and end at 12pm.
- All students must attend school in full school-uniform (they can bring a spare shirt to be signed).
- Any students not in uniform, or not following expectations will not be allowed to enter the school.
