



Salmon's Brook School Section 10 Consultation

Edmonton Academy Trust (EdAcT) is delighted to launch its Section 10 consultation in relation to its new Special Free School, Salmon's Brook School.

Salmon's Brook School is a newly built special school opening in September 2022, which caters for pupils who have social, emotional and mental health difficulties, including associated challenging behaviours. Pupils may have additional special educational needs such as autistic spectrum disorder (ASD) attention deficit and hyperactive disorders (ADHD) and speech, language and communication needs (SCLN). The school will have capacity to educate 70 pupils in the 11 to 19 age range.

What is a section 10 consultation?

As part of the process of opening a new school, EdAcT is legally required to hold a consultation exercise ([under Section 10 of the Academies Act 2010](#)) to determine whether the Department for Education should enter into a funding agreement with EdAcT.

This consultation allows parents/carers and pupils, staff and governors from local schools, other local authorities, councillors, local residents and any other interested parties to learn more about EdAcT's plans for Salmon's Brook School and share their views. The consultation period takes place from 13 December 2021 to 21 January 2022. This is an important step in our journey to opening in September 2022. We would like to hear from the community over the period of consultation to help inform the Secretary of State for Education's decision on whether to enter into a Funding Agreement with the us. We welcome your comments and feedback to ensure Salmon's Brook School is the best it can be and meets the needs of the community we serve.
