## **Year 11 study leave**

From today we have placed the year 11 students on study leave. This means that your son/daughter needs only attend school on the days when they have an exam. However, the school will be offering exam warm up and preparation sessions which will include final tips and strategies but more importantly reassurance to get them through the stressful exam period.
