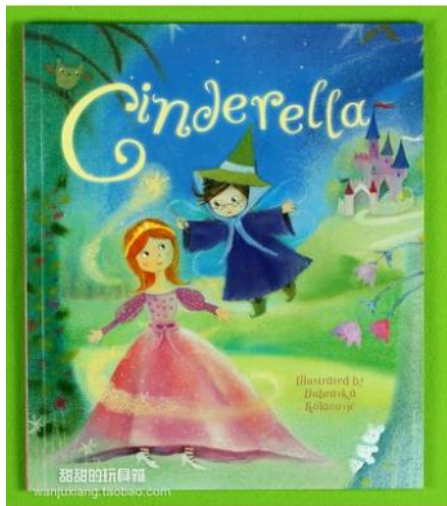
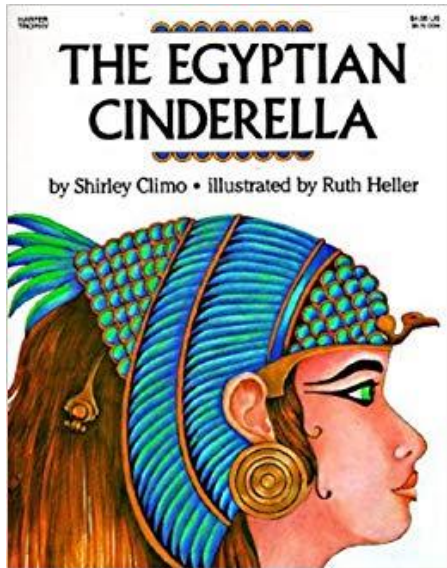

This week year 4 has had lots of fun working on Egyptian Cinderella story.



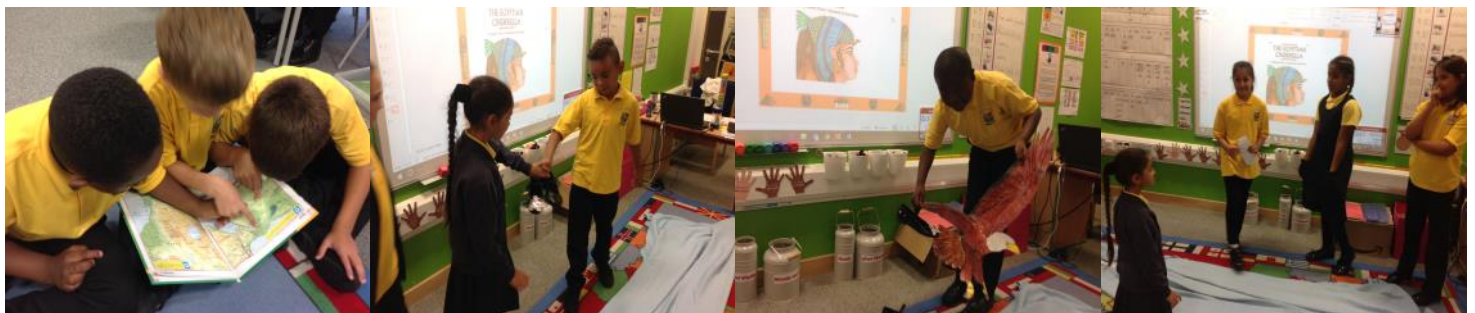

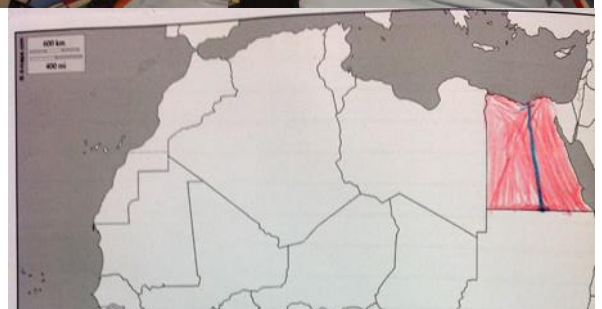


We practised using various conjunctions when comparing characters from the story. We deepened our understanding by acting out the story using animated voice and actions.

It is your responsibility to advise the Primary School Office if your child is packed lunch, otherwise we will assume they are having school dinners.

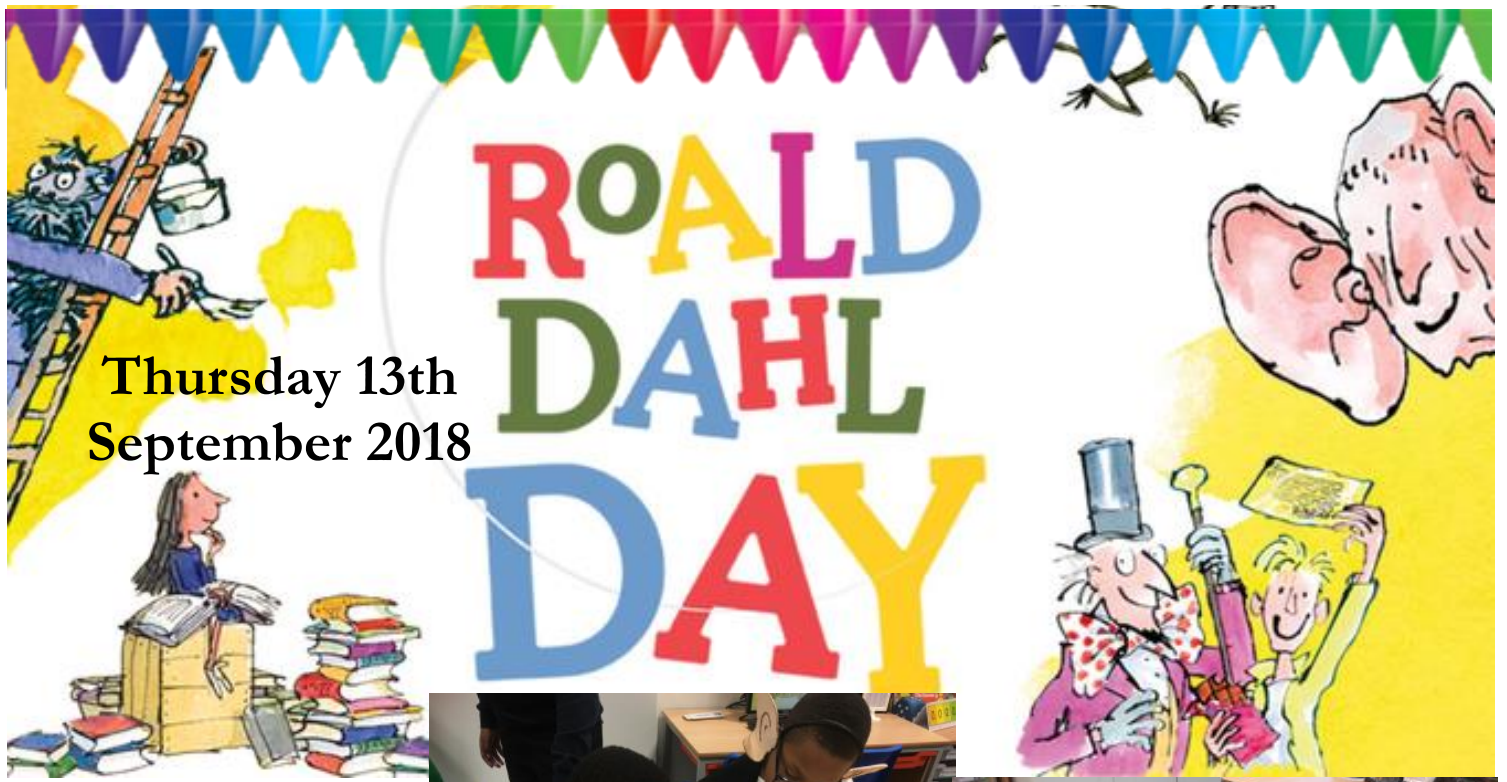

The cost of school meals is £2.10 a day, £10.50 a week.

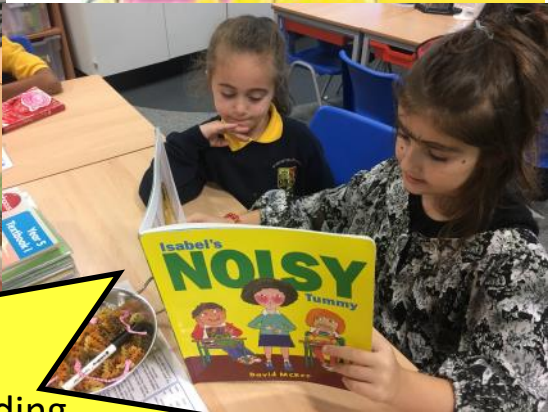
POLITE NOTICE TO PARENTS/CARERS
