**Keep in Touch Meetings:** The Autumn Term is racing along – we are now in Week 5! Advance notice that the first 'Keep in Touch' sessions for you to meet with your child's teacher will be held in the week beginning November 5<sup>th</sup>. I hope you will all make every effort to attend these - research has shown that strong partnerships between parents and teachers have a positive impact on a child's progress and helps them to feel good about school. It is vital that a child feels that the important people in their life are all working together. Sign-up lists will be on classroom doors shortly.

**Show Me 5:** The school-parent partnership also ensures that children are getting a consistent message about good behaviours. Most of you will know about our school behaviour monitoring system, 'Good to be Green' and our 5 school rules which we call 'Show me 5':

- 1) Show me you are ready to learn
- 2) Show me you are a good listener
- 3) Show me you are a kind friend
- 4) Show me you hard working
- 5) Show me you look after our school

**Edmonton County Secondary Open Evening:** It was lovely to see so many Year 5 and 6 children and parents at last week's Open Evening event, taking the opportunity to explore and find out more about our highly successful secondary phase. We are a heavily over-subscribed school, with progress at GCSE (Year 11) consistently in the top 30% of schools nationally, and progress at A Level (Year 13) consistently in the top 10% of Sixth Forms nationally. # ? What has my child been learning this week? ?

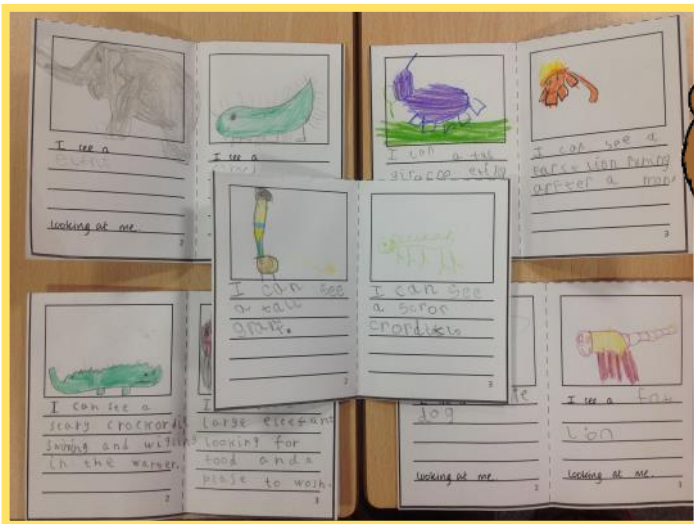
## Year 1
