Dear Parents / Carers,

A warm welcome back to you and your children after the half-term holiday. I hope you all had an enjoyable and relaxing break. Winter is approaching and your children will no doubt be wrapped up against the cold. This is a good opportunity to remind you of our uniform expectations, which we need all parents / carers to adhere to:

Uniform: We are seeing children coming into school with outer jackets which are not part of the uniform. Only navy blue or black jackets are allowed if your child does not have an Edmonton County Primary jacket. With the colder season almost upon us, if your child is wearing a hat, this should be the Edmonton County hat, however, if you do not have one, please ensure this is navy blue or black and no sport markings, the same with gloves and scarves please. Firework safety: With Bonfire Night / Guy Fawkes Night (November 5th) and Diwali (November 7th) approaching, this is the time of the year where families can enjoy fireworks and bonfire celebrations. However, despite annual safety warnings, firework celebrations still end in painful injuries for too many people, including very young children. The safest place to enjoy fireworks is at a large public display - far fewer people are injured here than at smaller family or private parties. 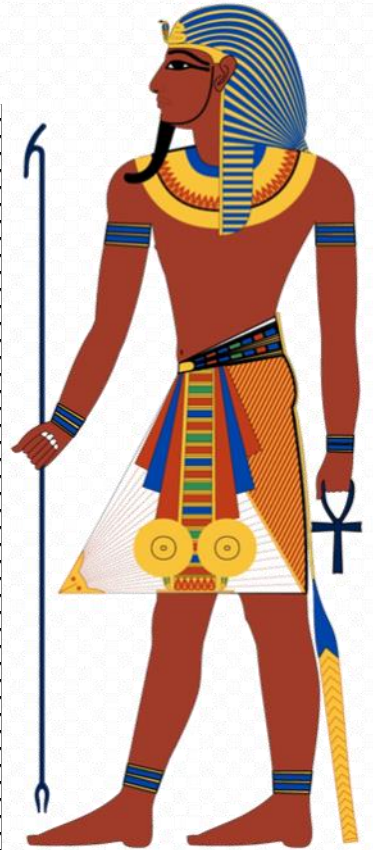
What we've Been Learning This week



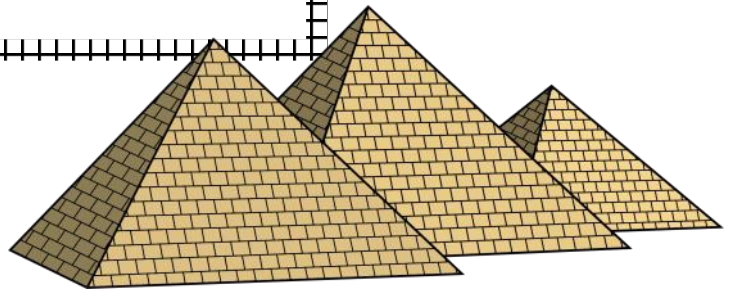
Year 4

and for a kind donation of £1, which will go towards the charity, helping disadvantaged children.

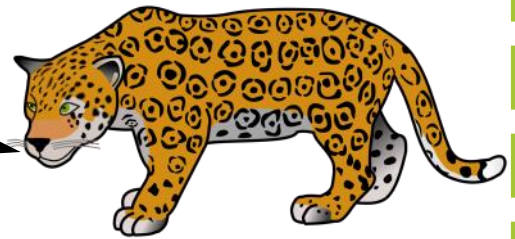

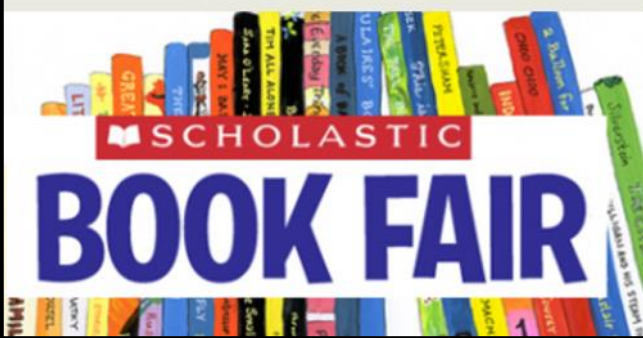

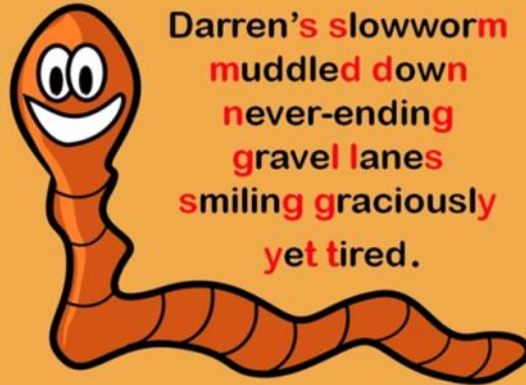

The Sentence

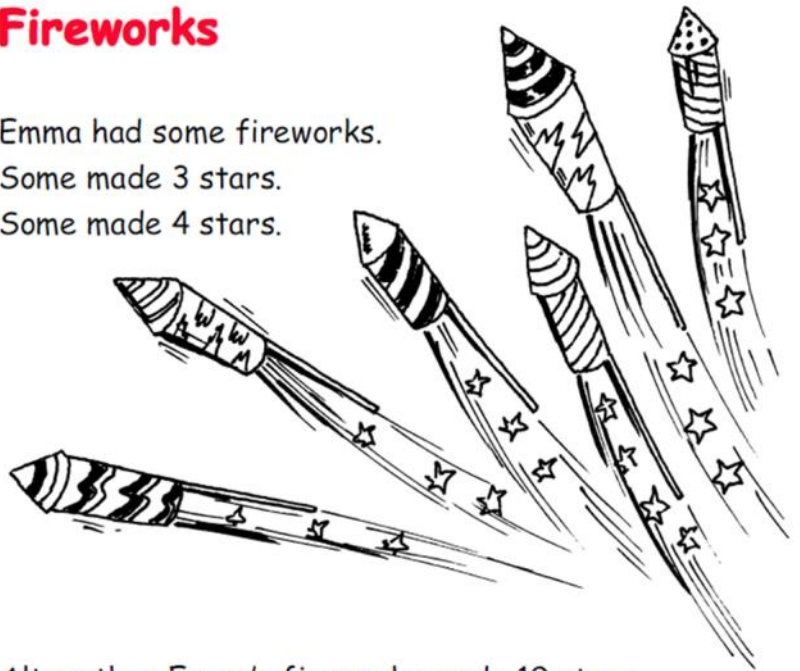
Each new word must start with the last letter of the previous word. Ensure that the chain of words makes sense when read back as a sentence. How long can you make your sentence?
