We are asking children to come in dressed with spotty clothing on

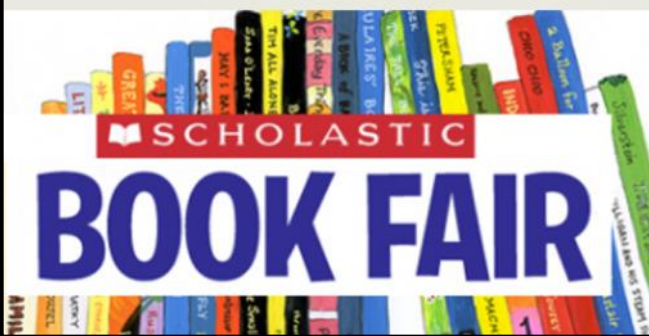
