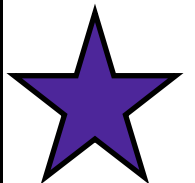
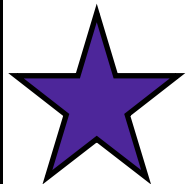
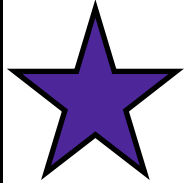

Staff on duty in the playground areas are giving children who demonstrate particularly kind, helpful, responsible and sensible behaviour a Playground Diamond Ticket. The class who gets the most tickets each week will be in line for a reward or treat!

We have detected a case of head lice in school. Please check your child's hair daily for the next few weeks and on a regular basis thereafter.

What to look for:

- Adult lice are small (about the size of a sesame seed).
- Eggs are usually found firmly attached to the base of the hair shaft.
- Lice stay near the scalp, often behind the ears, near the neckline, and back of the head.
- Head lice hold tightly to the hair. They move by crawling. They cannot hop or fly (they do not have wings), but do move quickly making it difficult to find in a child's hair.
- Signs of a head lice infestation include: itchy scalp, tickling sensation in a person's hair. Head lice are most active in the dark.

Uniform

Please ensure that your child has their FULL PE kit kept in school.

PE For both boys and girls –

- White round neck t shirt (with Edmonton County Primary logo)
- Navy shadow strip shorts
- Navy tracksuit bottoms (optional for the winter)
- Navy tracksuit top (with logo, optional for the winter)
- Black plimsolls

Uniform for both Girls and Boys

- Navy blue sweatshirt or cardigan (with Edmonton County Primary logo)
- Gold polo shirt (with Edmonton County Primary logo)
- Navy Edmonton County reversible coat or navy or black outdoor school coat
- Edmonton County book bag or ruck sack
- Edmonton County PE bag
- Edmonton County winter hat (or dark coloured hat, with no markings)
- Navy knee length skirt or pinafore (not black)
- Black tailored trousers (not leggings)
- Navy/black socks or tights
- Black sensible shoes (not trainers with markings)

Long hair must be tied back and all accessories including religious headwear needs to be navy or black.

Children may wear a black or navy watch and small stud earrings (please ensure that earrings are NOT worn on the day of your child's PE lesson). No other jewellery is permitted.

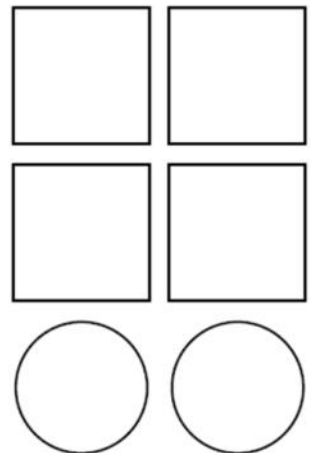
