Playground Diamond Ticket

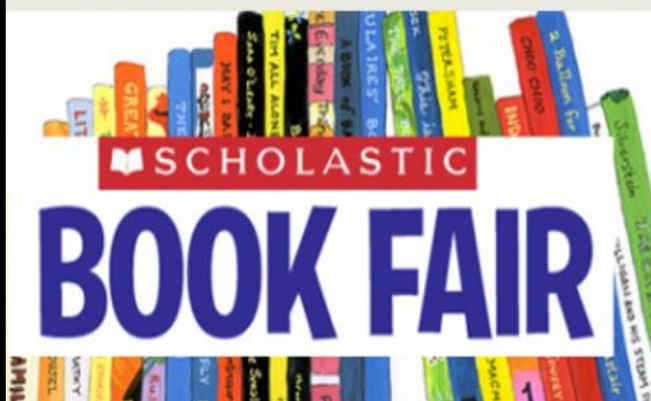

How amazing!

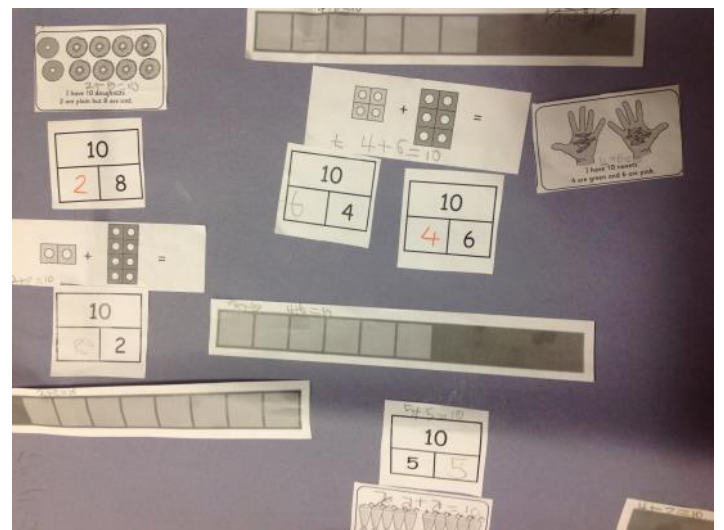
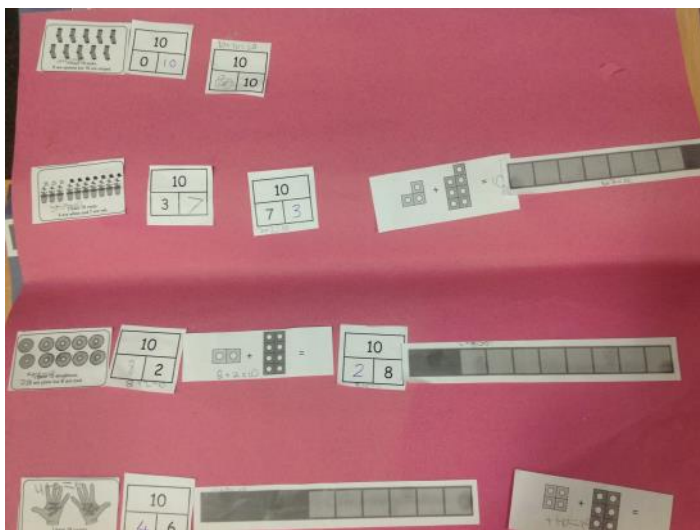
What We've Been Learning Year 1 This Week
