## After School Clubs – Spring 1 Term

After School Clubs will start Monday 14 January to 29<sup>th</sup> March 2019

All clubs need to be paid in **FULL** for the 11 week term via our Parentpay System before Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> December

Please see **IMPORTANT** club Terms and Conditions.

Please indicate your order of preference for clubs. Please allocate a number in order of preference (1<sup>st</sup> choice: 1, 2<sup>nd</sup> choice 2, 3<sup>rd</sup> choice 3 etc)

All clubs need to be paid in **FULL** for the eleven week term via our Parentpay system by Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2018

Please note that if your Parentpay (including lunch account) is in debt, your application will **NOT** be considered

Children who do not follow the behaviour rules in Clubs: Our After School Clubs are oversubscribed and very popular- we have a “three strike rule” and any child who does not follow our club rules could potentially be banned from further clubs.

On 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> occasion – you will receive a note from the Club Leader advising you of your child’s behavior – and they will be temporarily banned for the following week for that particular club (they will not be allowed to attend any other club on that day).

On 3<sup>rd</sup> occasion your child will be given their final warning and again you will receive a note from the club leader advising of this – they will not be allowed to attend this particular or any of our clubs for the remainder of the term.

Your child will need to be collected promptly after the club – if you are late collecting your child on more than 3 occasions your child’s name will be removed from the club registers.

All parents/carers that have a child attending our After School Clubs will be automatically accepting and agreeing our terms and conditions on behavior and lateness by making full payment for clubs, which will be advised by a Parentpay letter.

Please complete and return the reply slips to the class teacher/office by Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2018. Our clubs have proved to be in demand and places are limited. Any forms received after this date will not be allocated a club.

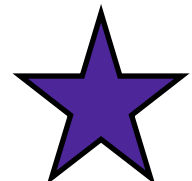

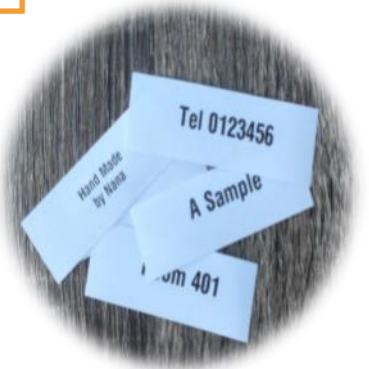

# What We've Been Learning

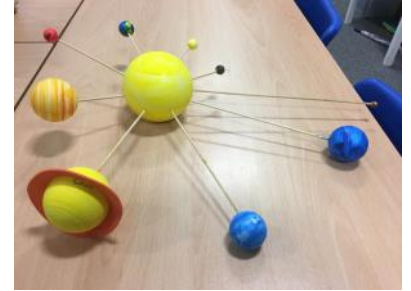
## Year 5



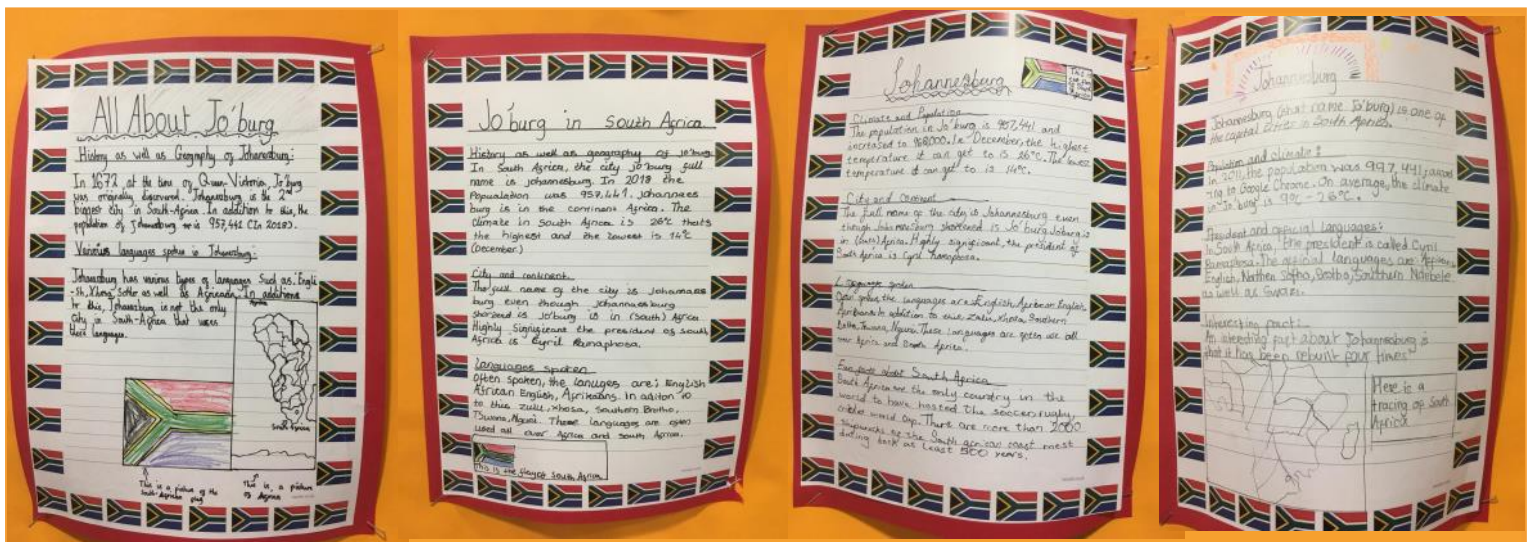
Before and over the Christmas break some children created their very own Space models, here are photographs of some of them. Mr. Miller was so impressed

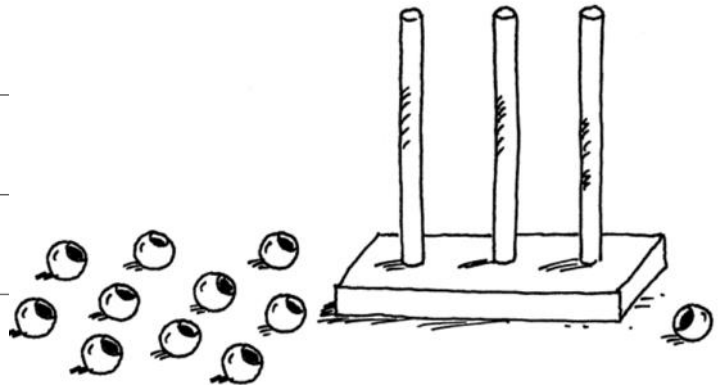
