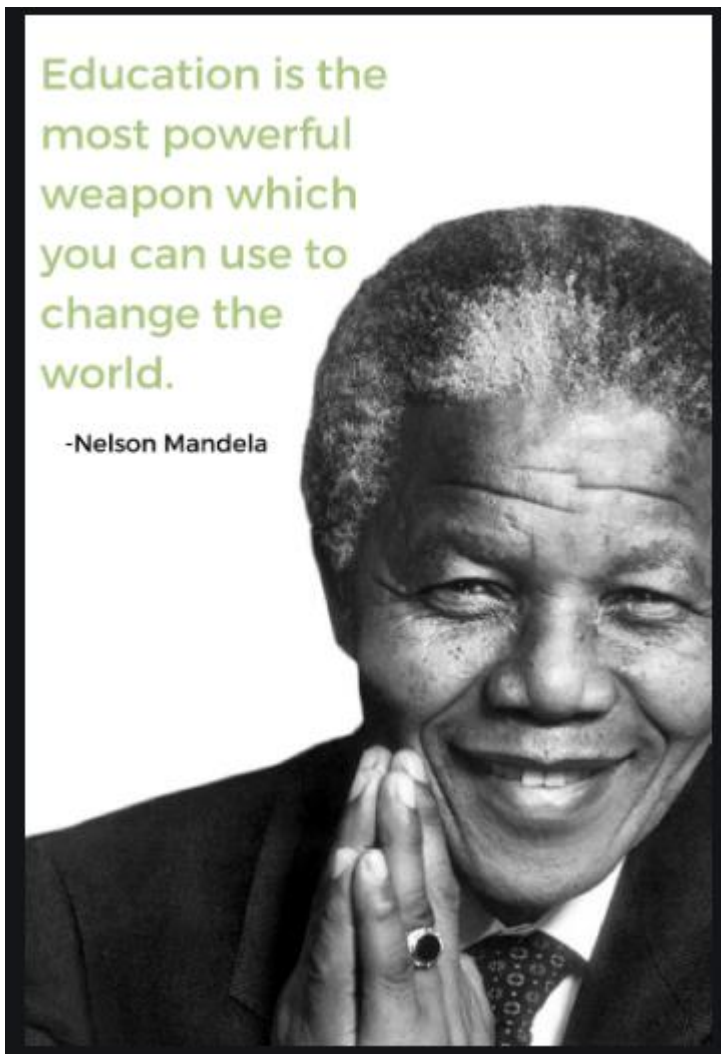

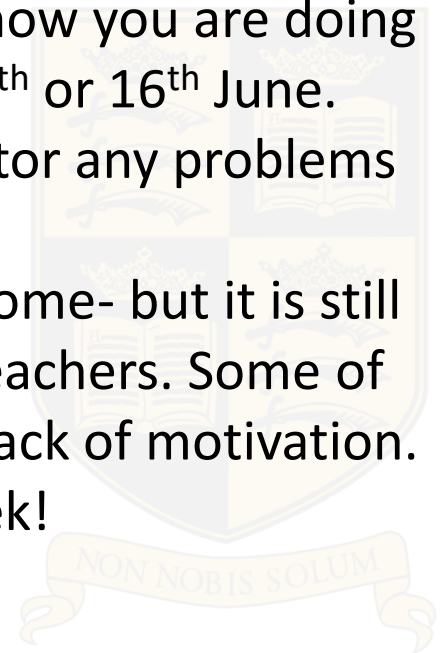
ARD Pupil and Parent Meetings

Government Guidance

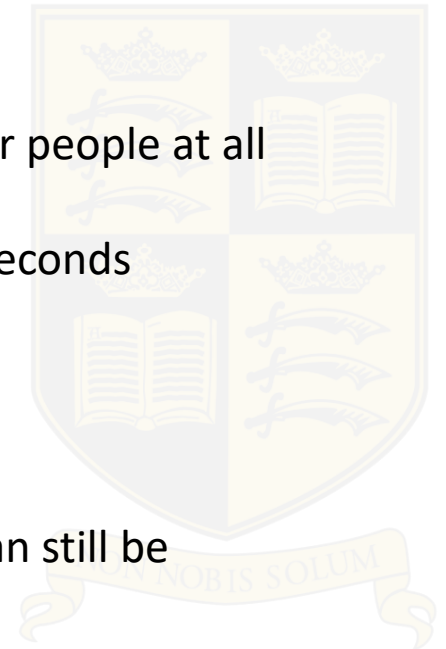
Remember government guidance for Covid-19 prevention:

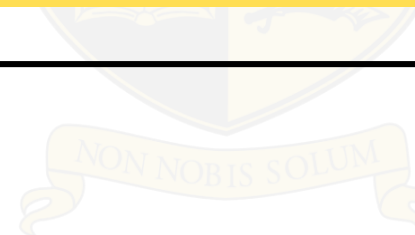
