Funfetti Cake Mix Cookies

Please check for any allergies before making



Ingredients

8 tbsp unsalted
butter melted
1 egg room temperature
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
4 oz light cream cheese,
room temperature
box of cake mix
1 - 2 tbsp sprinkles or
anything else you want to
add

Instructions

1. Combine butter, egg, vanilla, and cream cheese in a large mixing bowl and beat until thoroughly combined.
2. Add cake mix, half of the box at a time, stirring just until combined.
3. Stir in sprinkles.
4. Refrigerate the cookie for at least one hour.
5. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
6. Scoop out cookie dough and roll into balls.
7. Place dough balls onto a parchment lined baking sheet about 2 inches apart. Use the bottom of a measuring cup to flatten the cookie dough into a disc-shape. Or leave as a ball if you want a more rounded cookie.
8. Bake for 9 minutes - you don't want the cookies to brown at all!
9. Let the cookies cool on a baking sheet for several minutes before removing to a wire rack to cool completely.
10. Cookies can be stored in an airtight container for 4 to 5 days.
