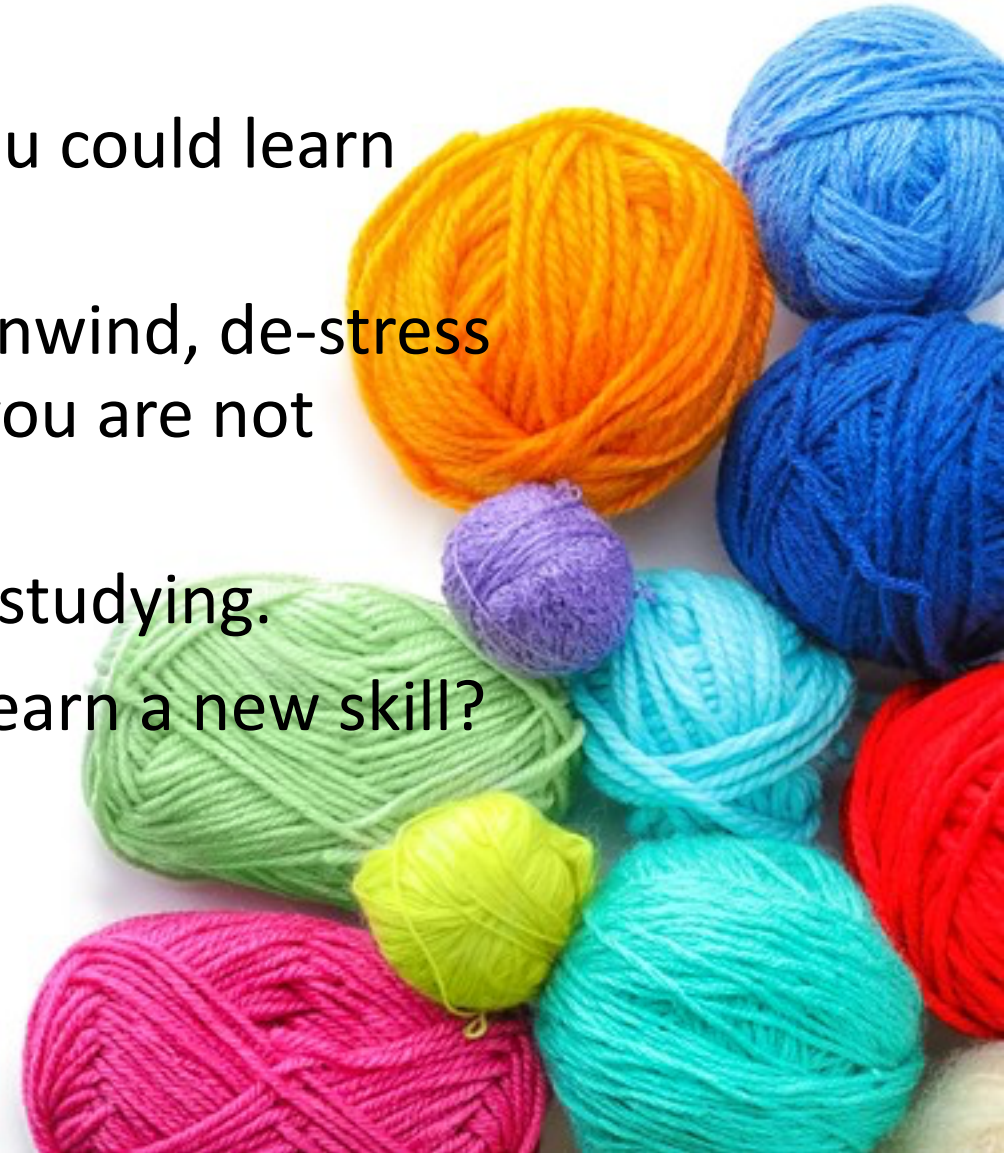


Crafts During Lockdown

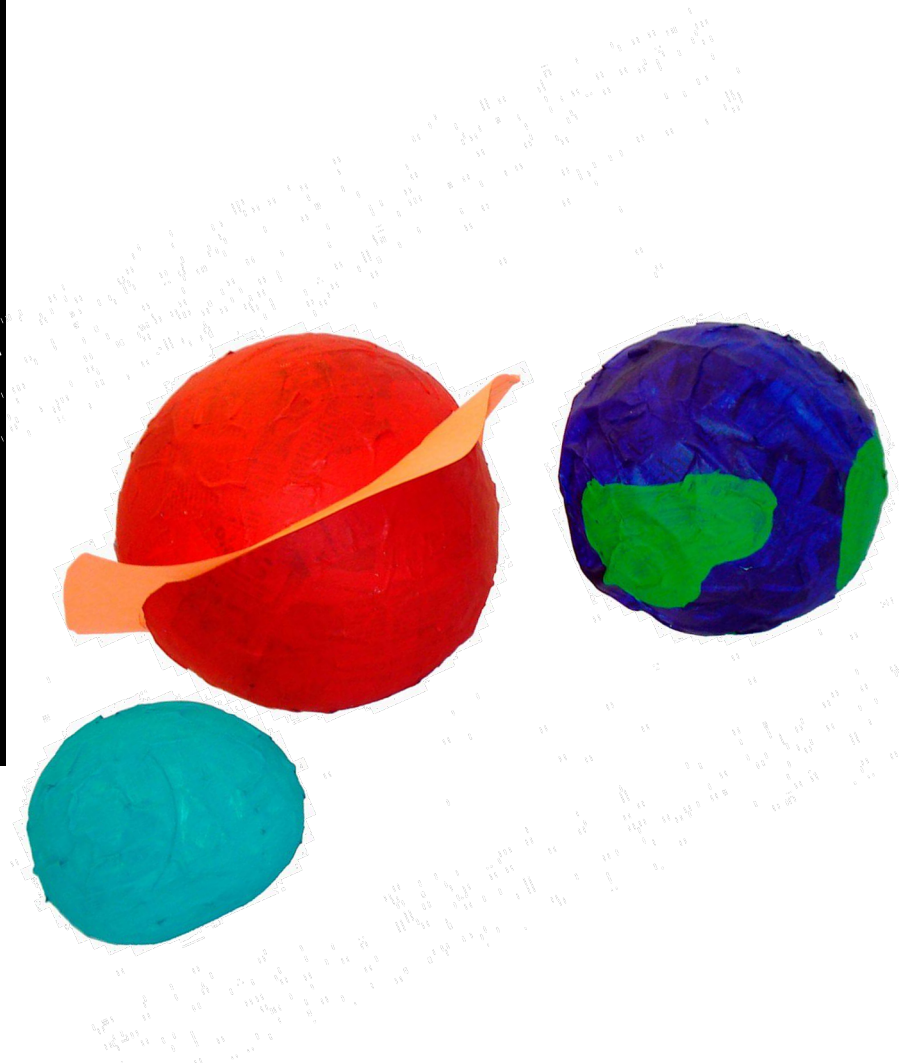

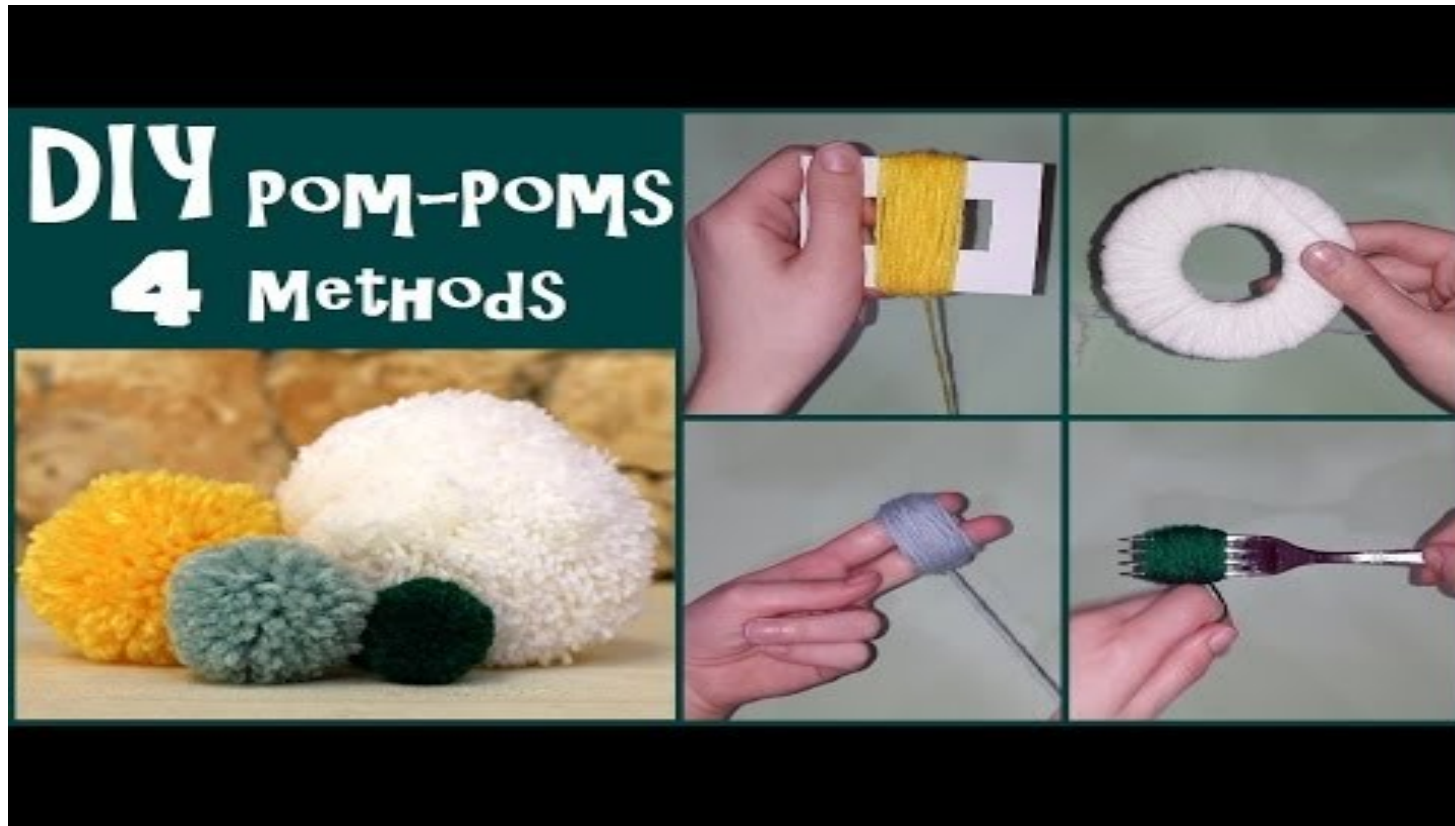
