Letter from the Head of School

Dear Parents and carers,

Last week we held our Sixth Form Celebration Evening to celebrate the achievements of students now in Year 12 and 13, during their time in Year 11 and 12. It was a particular pleasure for students, parents and staff to gather together to celebrate success after the disruption caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. Whilst 2021-22 was a relatively normal school year, the education of all children was affected in the previous two years, despite the best efforts of schools, parents and (of course) students. It is even more commendable then, that we had so many achievements to celebrate. In addition to Year 12 students receiving their GCSE examination certificates, over 50 awards were given out in three categories:

- Top Achievers Awards
- Contribution to the Sixth Form Awards
- Leadership Awards

Pre-public exams (PPEs): A reminder that Year 11, 12 and 13 students will be sitting practice 'pre-public exams' over the next 2 weeks, starting from Monday 5th December. These will provide teachers with detailed information about the strengths and areas for development for each of their students, and will inform our revision programmes in the Spring Term. Therefore, it is really important that students revise thoroughly, attend school on time and arrive fully equipped for each exam. Students should remember that their January Predicted Grades will be based on the outcomes of the PPEs. Parents should note that Year 11 Period 6 lessons will be suspended from Monday 5th December until the end of term, resuming on Monday 9th January.

IMPORTANT EXAMINATION INFORMATION**Pre-Public Examinations Three (Year 11) and Pre-Public Examinations 1 (Sixth Form)**

Below is the timetable for Year 11 PPE3 and Sixth Form PPE1 examinations; copies of which will be found in the exams sections on the school website and will also be displayed around school. Individual Candidate Timetables will be sent to students and parents through In Touch, so students will need to check their emails.

Students will be attending lessons as normal when not sitting an exam.

EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENTS

- Make sure you check the seating plans posted in the playground in case there is a change of room for your exam (line up in the playground at least 15 minutes before the start time)
- Bring all the equipment you will need for the exam [black pens, pencils, ruler, calculator (where allowed), protractor, compasses]
- Full school uniform/smart business wear needs to be worn, with IDs placed on the exam desk
- Make sure you understand the rules
- Mobile phones/ watches, or any other product with potential technological/web enabled sources of information must be switched off and put in bags. **Any student found with such a device on them in an exam room will face disqualification from that exam**
- Any pencil cases taken into the exam room must be see-through
- Only small water bottles will be allowed into the exam room and must have all labels removed

You must not take into the exam room:

- notes
- a calculator case/instruction leaflet

Listen to the invigilators and follow their instructions during the exam.

Why is it important to vote in the EYP Election process?

You must be aged between 11-19 (up to 25 with SEND) and live or go to school in Enfield to vote. Your candidates will go live from Monday 16 January 2023 and voting will close on Thursday 26 January 2023.

Evening and weekend GP appointments are available seven days a week at GP hubs in Enfield. This article contains everything you need to know to book an appointment.

Evening and weekend GP appointments are available seven days a week at GP hubs in Enfield.

GP hubs are staffed by experienced GPs and nurses and offer assessment and treatment for adults and children with minor injuries and illnesses.

Both routine and same-day appointments are offered, subject to availability.

Appointments take place by phone, video, or face to face – depending on your clinical need.

There are four GP hubs in Enfield. Anyone who is registered with an Enfield GP, or lives in Enfield but hasn't yet registered with a GP, can request an appointment at any of the locations.
