Letter from the Head of School

Mr P Miller

Dear Parents and carers,

I hope you have been able to have a restful and peaceful festive period. This week we have welcomed students back after the Christmas holidays, and it is important that we get straight back to focusing on learning and making progress. Some key reminders:

Attendance and Punctuality: There is a very strong link between a child's attendance at school and the exam grades they achieve. Please help us secure the best possible progress for your child by ensuring they are in school, and on time to school. We expect at least 96% attendance for all students. Any student arriving after 8:25 is late to school and is likely to receive a 30 minute after-school detention that day. A reminder that the school will not give parents / carers permission to take their children out of school for family holidays during term time.

Uniform: Our full uniform policy is published on the school's website, but a couple of reminders as the weather becomes more autumnal:

- Students' coats, hats and scarves should be black or navy blue
- hoodies are not allowed in school
- students should always be wearing their blazers (except during PE activities), but can also wear the optional school jumper under their blazer

Behaviour in the Local Community: As part of the school's code of conduct, all students agreed to:

- Behave in a manner that shows respect for the community and for one another
- Treat members of the wider local community with respect and consideration.

This is particularly important around the A10 terrace of shops which are well-used by the local community. Students are expected to be respectful and show consideration to shopkeepers and their customers. Students should be leaving this area by 3:30pm (Years 7-10, 12&13) or 4:30pm (Year 11).

You need to be between 11-19 (up to 25 with SEN) to vote

Why is it important to vote in the EYP Election process?

Register to vote for young people who will represent you on the Enfield Youth Council and the UK Youth Parliament. You must be aged between 11-19 (up to 25 with SEND) and live or go to school in Enfield to vote. Your candidates will go live from Monday 16 January 2023 and voting will close on Thursday 26 January 2023.

It is important you Register to Vote Now, so you don't miss out on voting for the right candidate for you. Everyone who registers to vote will be entered into the Registration Raffle see below details.

Make sure to register by 14 January 2023 to be in for the chance of winning:
